



Booking Policy

The NYC Film-Makers' Cooperative allows institutions to loan 16mm films for exhibition. If renting a DVD or digital file, renter must agree to non-duplicity terms and conditions. To rent a film, please browse our online film catalogue, submit a rental request, and provide shipping and billing information. A Film Coop staff member will follow up for additional information and send you an invoice confirming your booking. Please note that submitting a booking request does not guarantee the availability of the film.

Booking requests should be made within two weeks of a proposed screening date. Any request received less than two weeks in advance is subject to a \$50.00 rush fee.

We cannot quote shipping rates, as we only ship on provided FedEx, DHL and UPS accounts.

Renters must return films the day following the screening date, excluding weekends or holidays. Films must be sent back (insured for \$150/pound) by FedEx, United Parcel Service, or other express carrier, so long as the shipment is registered and able to be tracked. Failure to do so will result in the renter being liable financially for any lost or damaged shipment of films by the carrier. Late fee or return of rentals is \$25.00 per day.

Please note that our minimum base rate for all film rentals is \$40.00. Please bear with us as we continue updating the prices of the 5,000 films in our archive; if a title is listed as less than \$40.00 on the website, please contact FMC by email for an up-to-date price. Also note that all rates posted on the website refer to our domestic base rate. Any international booking is subject to two times the base rate.
